

## The Roman route

### PK----- Description

- 00,000- Leaving from Guissona by the old road that linked this town to Cervera. The road sign is in front of Cal Conilles' house.  
Take the path of gentle slope facing south.
- 00,600- leaving a right-handed path and going straight on.
- 01,100- Crossroads. Going straight on along the high voltage line.
- 01,750- Crossroads. Turning right.
- 01,750- On our right-hand side there is a shed in very poor conditions.
- 02,600- Crossroads, turning left. We find a village named Bellvehí ahead.
- 02,950- Turning right. We get in Bellvehí and we go around the village by the left-hand side until we come to a square with swings.
- 03,250- Going straight on and leaving the village.
- 03,450- crossroads of 5 paths. Turning right facing west.
- 03,550- crossroads. Going straight on.
- 04,000- crossing the Cervera- Guissona (L-311) road.
- 04,750- crossroads, taking the right path facing Torrefeta.
- 05,200- crossroads, turning right. Going around the village by the right-hand side. We set off for the Torrefeta spring.
- 05,700- Leaving from Torrefeta facing North to Guissona.
- 06,100- road junction. Going straight on to the Mare de Deu de Maig Hermitage.
- 07,400- crossroads. Going right to the Mare de Deu de Maig Hermitage.
- 07,700- crossroads. We find the hermitage on the left-hand side. Going straight on until You come to Guissona.
- 08,400 crossing the Cervera- Guissona road (L311) and going straight on until Guissona.
- 09,000 end of the route.
- 09,000 reaching La font de la Salut( spring) in Guissona.
